Students along with regular snacks, carried in their tiffin at least one food item which the tribal people consume like fruits, salad, millets, etc.

One activity was that students of grade 7 and grade 11 were asked to prepare a chart depicting the life and culture of tribal people. Second, students participated in Quiz competition. It was based on the life of Shri Bhagwan Birsa Munda.
